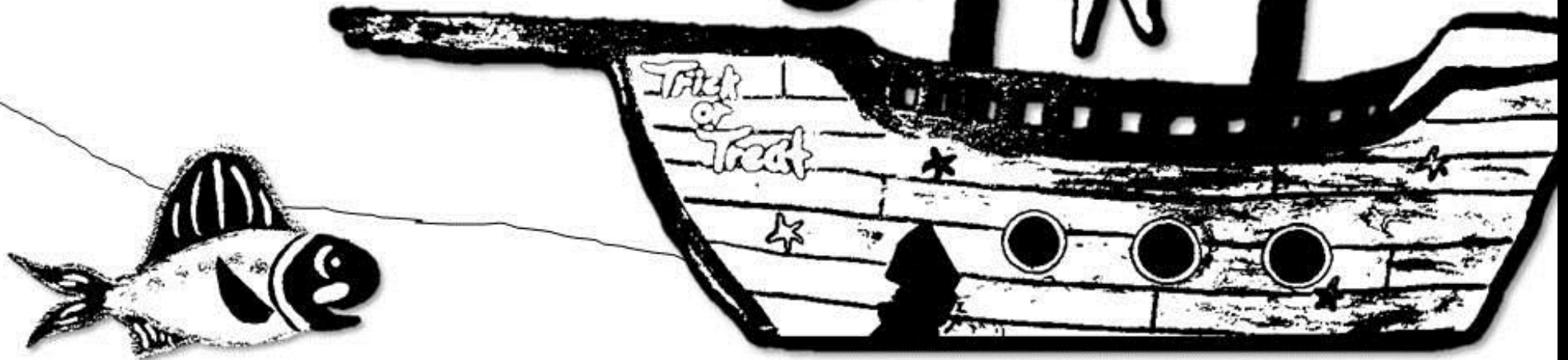

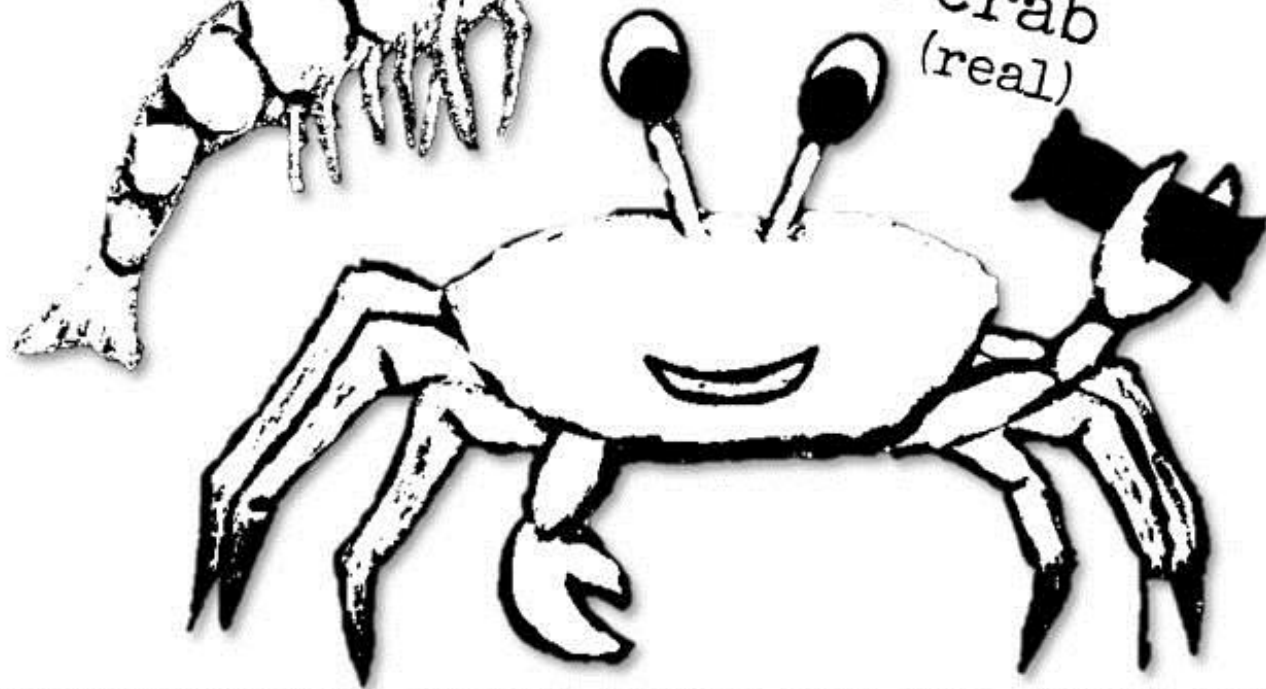

Ghost crabs and ghost shrimp are shy. They each dig burrows in the sand to live in tunnels in the beach.

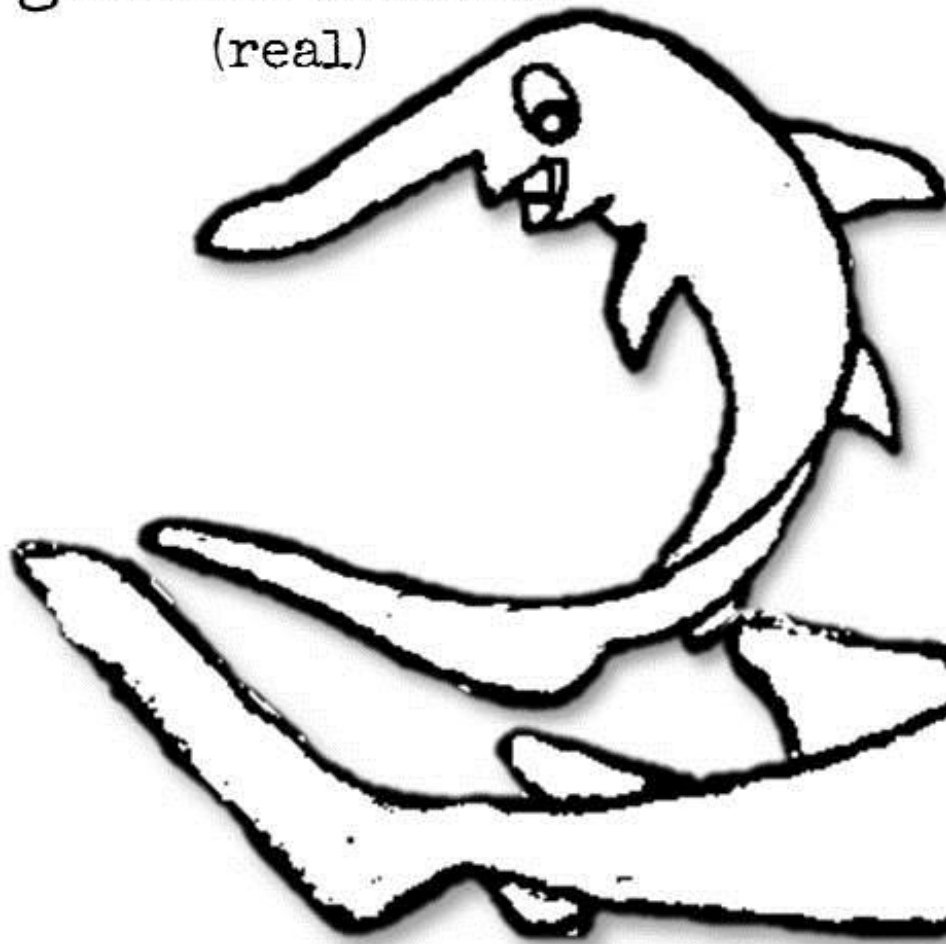

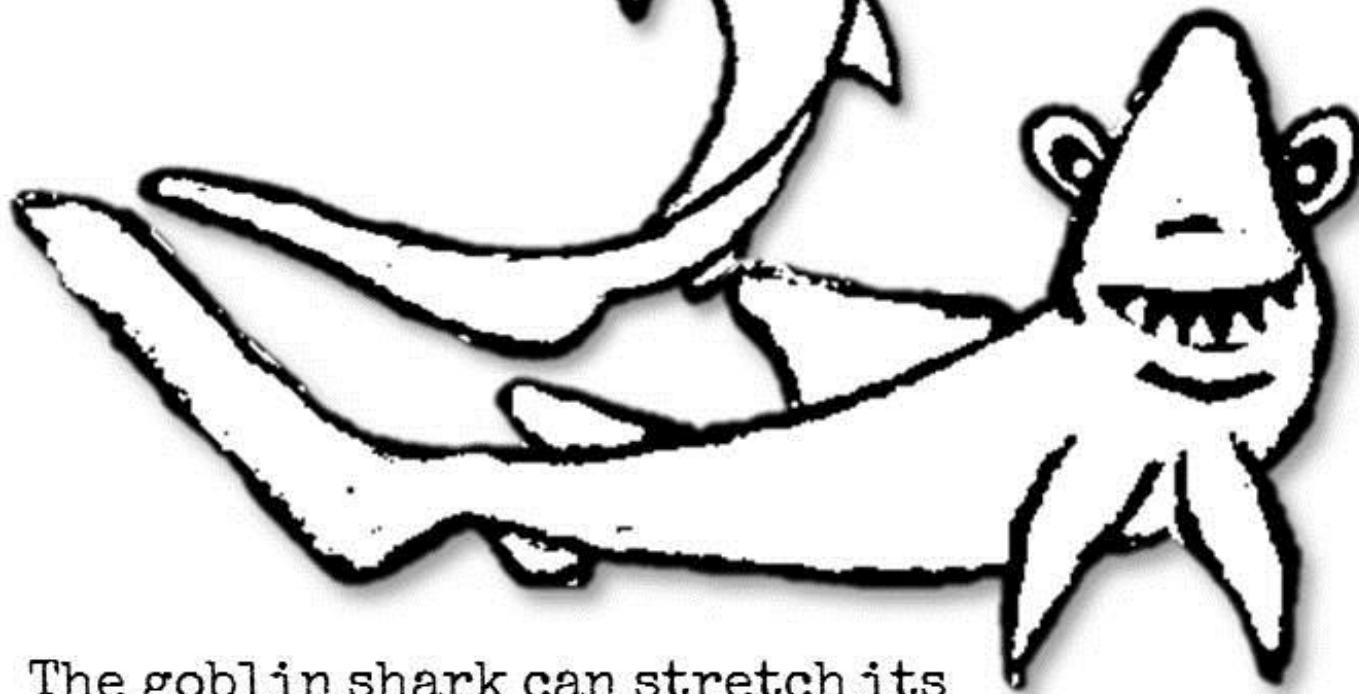

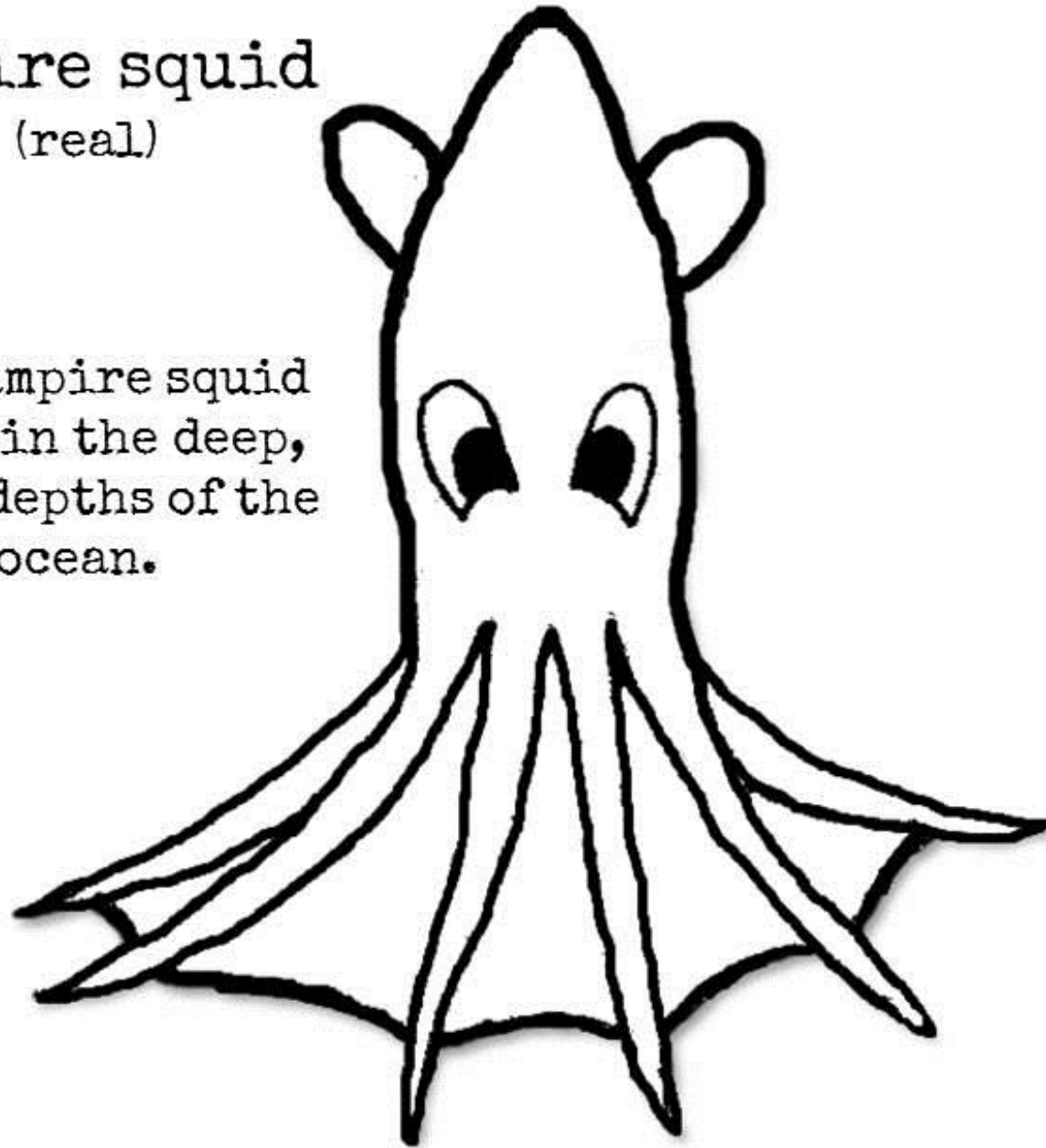

(The orange disappears, the black fades to gray, and they grow into a more full triangle shape.)

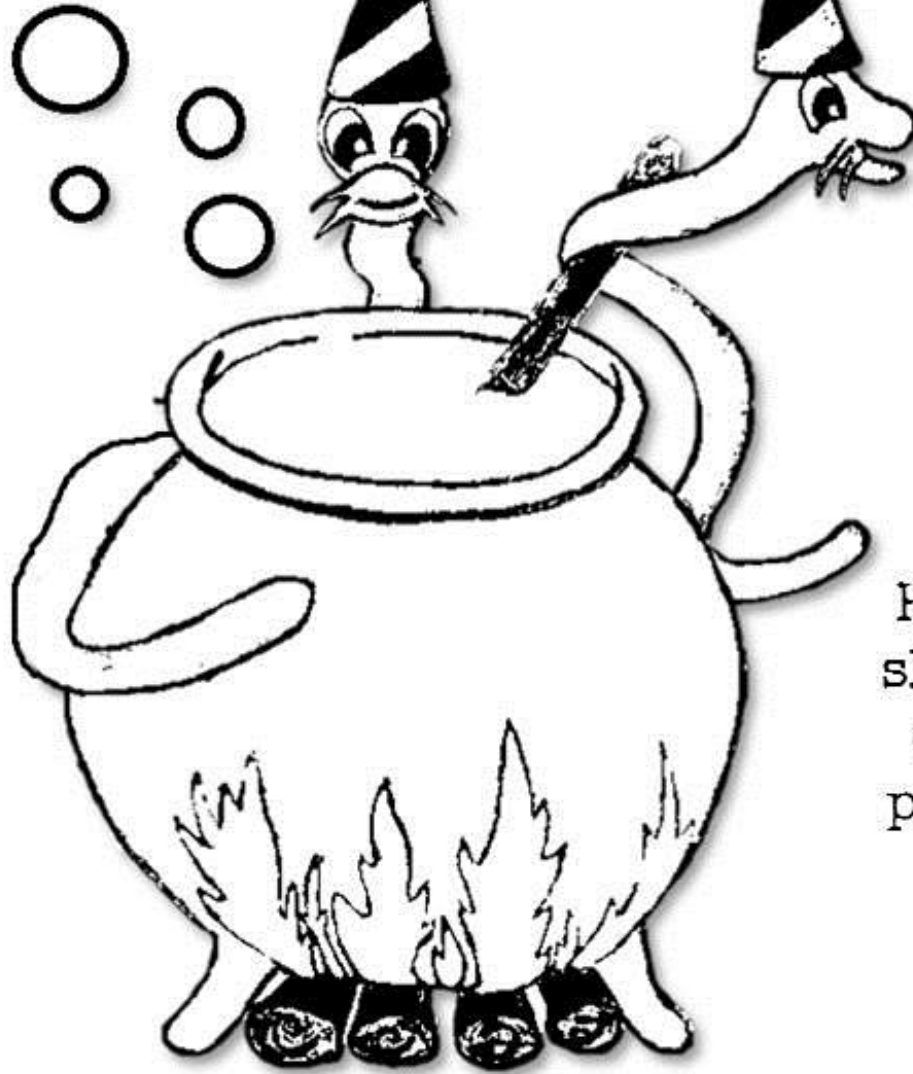

(Ew, gross!)

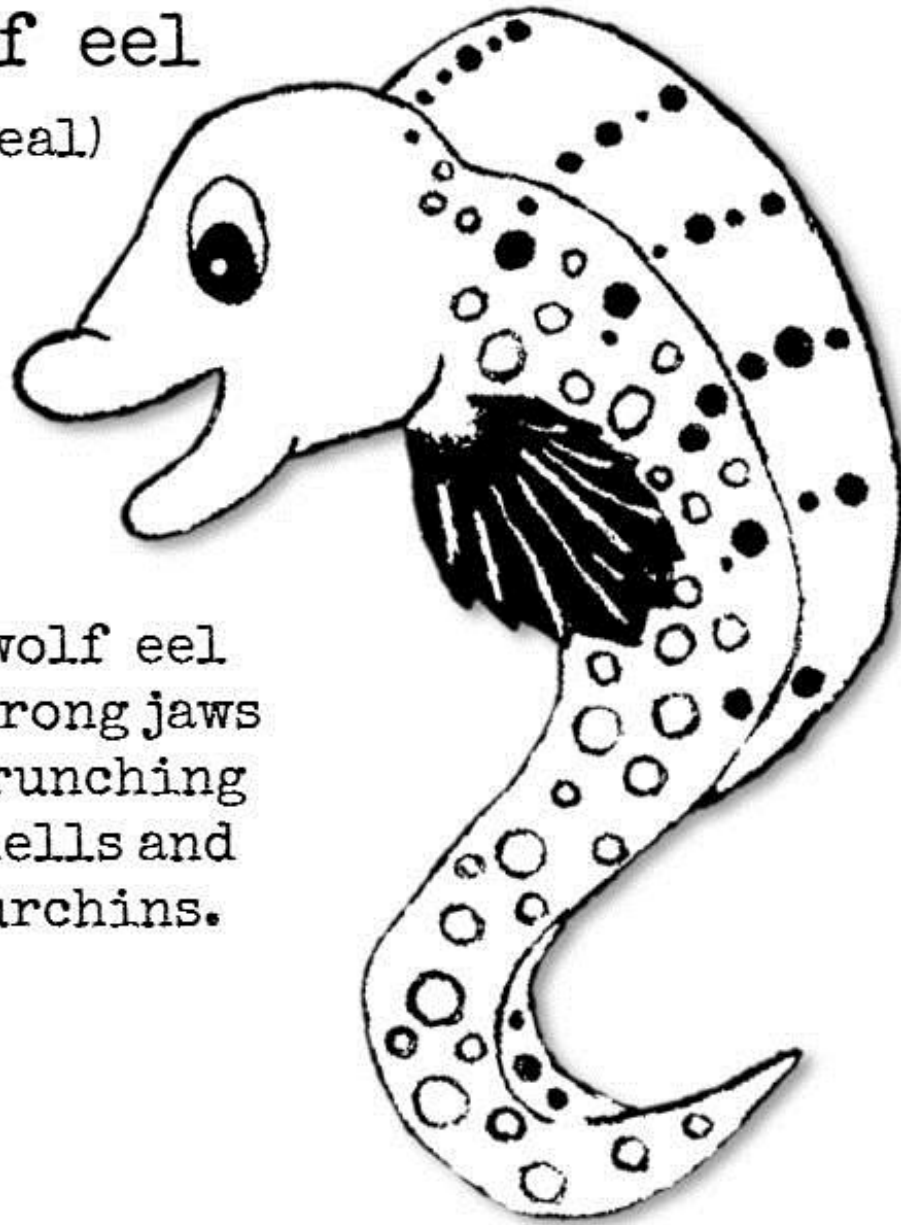

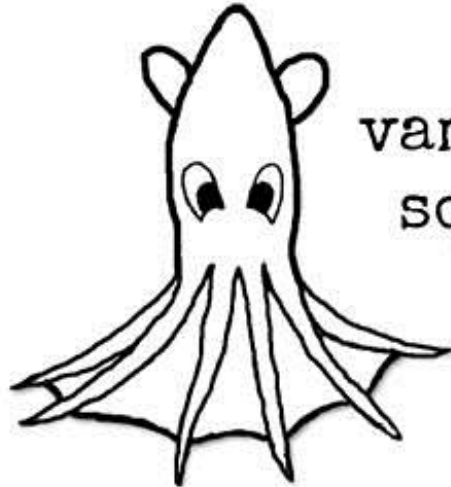
